Dear Dr. Kirwan and Members of the Commission on Innovation and Excellence in Education.

Thank you for serving on the commission to study and make recommendations to the state's education funding formula. As you know, Baltimore City schools are experiencing a funding crisis. We love our schools but they lack sufficient resources and programs — such as art, music, after school programs, counselors, paraprofessionals, sports, and more. The state's current "Thornton" formula intended to fulfill the state's constitutional responsibility to fund our schools adequately. However, the state cut the formula in 2008, which has led to a \$290 million shortfall according to a report to your commission in December 2016.

We are asking you to make recommendations that will ensure adequate funding for our schools. We need per pupil funding for PreK, sufficient special education funding, and additional funding for high poverty schools. Please make every effort to understand our situation and recommend an adequate and equitable formula.
